You are scheduled for a CT scan of your abdomen and pelvis at the following location:

What should I expect?

- Plan for the process to take about 3 hours from start to finish.
 - You should not eat or drink anything besides what the radiology department gives you until you are cleared by your doctor.
1. When you arrive at the University Ave. clinic, check in on the 1st floor at registration. Then continue up to the 3rd floor radiology department, and check in at the desk.
 2. The radiology receptionist will give you your next instructions:
 - Oral Contrast: Readicat – You will drink a bottle and your scan will be approximately 90 minutes later.
 - Oral Contrast: Isovue – You will drink 3 doses spaced out over 90 minutes with the scan immediately following your last dose.
 - Go to lab (4th floor) and get bloodwork drawn if required.
 - Additional testing _____
 3. You will be called from the waiting room by the technologist for your CT scan which will take about 20 minutes.

How do I get my results?

- Stay in radiology and wait to hear results and further instructions from your provider.
 - Return back to the ordering provider's office.
